# **Certification**

UMAAS Position:

- All municipalities should require certification including under 100 populations.
- Open to alternate education options moving into the future.
- Current shortage of certified people isn't improving.

President Chorneyko introduced and welcomed special guests.

#### Government Relations:

- Considering UMAAS position on certification.
- Agree that even small municipalities have lawmaking ability and right to tax so UMAAS position is definitely worth consideration.
- Education requirements:
  - Goal would be attraction of more skilled people that are not already in field.
  - Ministry pursuing opportunities with Saskpoly Tech
  - Not about down grading LGA, but about adding programming and education options.
  - U of R may be interested in exploring a practical component.

## **CAO Education:**

- Conditional Certificates
  - UMAAS receives over 50 applications per year.
  - $\circ$  Reaching those in need is biggest challenge.
  - Non compliant legislation will address some situations where standards are not being met.

## **Elected Official Education**

- Badly needed but again hard to reach those who need it the most.
- Keep encouraging Council's province wide
- Possible program related to 10 minute training videos being worked on.

# Peer Support Network

- Possible training from Municipal Relations for establishment of peer support network coaching colleagues.
