<u>CALL TO ORDER:</u> President Jason Chorneyko called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

<u>INTRODUCTIONS:</u> President Chorneyko introduced and welcomed special guests.

#### ORDER OF DISCUSSIONS:

#### **Legislative Amendments:**

- o Any size municipality to need a certified administrator?
- Currently municipalities with over 100 population certified administrators are required.
- Minister Carr confirmed that in the new legislation, all municipalities will require a certified administrator, no matter the size of the municipality.
- Municipalities that are not complying consequences revenue sharing may be withheld.
- o Effective date proposed January 1, 2021.

## **Disciplinary Committee:**

- o UMAAS has the most files they've ever had.
- UMAAS's capabilities to discipline or fine are limited in the Administrator's Act. (ie: \$50 fine amount for an uncertified administrator).
- o Minister's Policy Branch can help in discussions with amending the Urban Municipal Administrator's Act.
- Gov't Relations suggested that we consider amending other portions of the Act at the same time.

## Asset Management in Smaller Municipalities:

- o Challenges
  - implementation of the Asset Management Plan
  - time and manpower to do
  - capabilities to complete
  - need simplified spreadsheets?
- Gov't officials suggested using regional cooperation and applying for the Targeted Sector Funding Grant in this regard.

## 2020 Municipality Election Dates

 Municipal elections – issues with date changes and Remembrance Day conflict.

#### Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP)

o Program has some issues; working through them.

## <u>Advisory Services – Scope & Role</u>

- o Looking for legal advice/opinion from staff
- Acts do not allow this as it is no longer prescriptive but rather permissive.
- Gov't officials consider this to be a conflict where they've established the Act and then to give legal advice on their own Act becomes a conflict of interest.
- Suggested to use SUMA lawyer or possibility the Peer Network group in this capacity.

## Municipal Infrastructure Funding – Future Outlook:

- o Timeline for Infrastructure Grant Funding
  - December/19 applications to come out
  - March/20 applications due
  - Late Summer/20 Funding announced.
- To submit one priority in each sector (ie: Rec & Culture, Wastewater/Water, Green) only

#### Training Needs for CAOs:

- o Certification, education, etc.
- o Education requirements do not prepare for the job.
- o Certification program at Sask Polytech?
  - Committee working on this
- o U of R LGAA courses would continue
- o Sask Polytech would be new, separate program.
